## "HATS ON!" AT HOLY ROSARY FROM SEPTEMBER 1

At Holy Rosary, our SunSmart Policy notes that all children will be required to wear school broad brimmed hats from 'Hats On Day'- September 1 to 'Hats Off Day' - May 1, whenever they are outside including sports lessons.
