PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Firstly, a huge thank you to the volunteers at the Marong Cup, it was great to see parents answer the call and ensure that Holy Rosary had a great presence, although I'm sure a few people might stay away from 'slushies' for a while. Special thanks to Tamara, who with such a positive enthusiastic attitude was able to coordinate the day for our school. We certainly appreciate your efforts.

We will begin preparing for our Lenten Journey by celebrating Shrove Tuesday tomorrow. This follows the tradition where people used up all of the fats in the house that they would go without until Easter. Throughout the day the children will have the opportunity to share in pancake.

We also celebrate the return to school with an informal gathering in the Botanical Gardens, bring along your picnic tea and we can gather with some pancakes and time together, from 5 – 7pm.

Wednesday is the beginning of the church season of Lent. As a school we will attend Mass at 9.15am beginning our preparation for Easter. Lent is a time for self-discipline. Throughout the 40 days of Lent, people are called to fast and pray. But just before Lent starts, it has become a time of merrymaking, culminating on Shrove Tuesday, the day before Lent begins. The name Shrove Tuesday comes from the custom of ringing the 'shriving bell' to summon the people to church to be 'shriven', that is to confess their sins at the beginning of Lent. At that time, certain foods like eggs, milk, meat and rich buttery dishes were given up for the duration of Lent. One way that they used up the eggs, milk and fats in the house was to add flour to make special pancakes. In England, the popularity of pancakes caused Shrove Tuesday to be called Pancake Day, a tradition we also follow here in Australia.

Last week was a busy week for our swimmers and it was great to see the participation by so many. Congratulations to Frayne house on their victory. Thank you to all our helpers, in particular the grade 6 children who were wonderful in their care for others spending a lot of extra time in the pool encouraging and supporting others. Thank you to Mr Coates for organising the day and backing up again with the Catholic sports, it is certainly never underestimated the amount of time and effort required to ensure a successful and safe day.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE - CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)

The Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF) is a Victorian Government program that assists eligible families to cover the cost of school trips, camps and sporting activities. Any parents/carers who hold a valid means-tested concession card, a Gold DVA card or are a temporary foster parent, may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance is paid directly to the school to use towards these items.

ATTENDANCE

The importance of arriving at school and class on time:


