PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Next week between the 1st and 3rd August, Holy Rosary will participate in a school review using the National School Improvement Tool (NSIT). NSIT focuses on school improvement in teaching and learning and is designed to assist schools to review and reflect on their efforts to improve the quality of teaching and learning and improve outcomes for students.

NSIT facilitates school-wide conversations with parents and families, local communities, staff, school governing bodies and students about current practice, areas for improvement and evidence that progress is being made.

The reviewers are wanting to speak to parents, as well as the School Council throughout the review process. If you are available for a short period between 2:30pm and 3:15pm on Tuesday 1st August, please let me know via email and we will work to schedule you into the timetable. The panel will also be around the school before and after school to have an impromptu chat at drop off or pick up time.

It's great to see our children arriving at school each morning with plenty of time to get themselves organised and be ready for the day ahead. Thank you to parents for establishing these vitally important routines. It is essential that a smooth start to the day is established so that children are given every opportunity to participate fully in their learning.

We ask that you continue to ensure that the children arrive on time ready to start their day before the music begins playing at 8:55am. It is interesting to note that even arriving 10 minutes late a day adds up to 50 minutes a week which is equivalent to one and a half weeks of valuable learning time each year.

We have also noted a few very early arrivals, in fact prior to 8.00am. A reminder that students should not be onsite before 8.30am as no supervision is available. Before School Care is available from 7.00am if this is required.

Our Learning Conversations wrap up today, with 4BD's alternate timetable. These conversations are an important opportunity for you to sit with your child and their teacher and discuss the achievements and challenges of the first semester and to set goals and actions for the remaining terms. Everything tells us that positive, supportive relationships between the learner, parents and school have strong benefits for your child. Thank you for taking this opportunity.

NAPLAN results for students in Grades 3 and 5 will be sent home this afternoon. We have been informed of some changes to this year's reporting. These are changes being introduced nationally by the Australian Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA). NAPLAN will continue to measure student achievement in numeracy, reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation but the results will now be presented in 4 proficiency levels - exceeding, strong, developing and needs additional support.

This change will give schools and parents clearer information that details student achievement against new proficiency levels. Students' NAPLAN reports will continue to show how they are tracking against their peers and provide an indication of their skill levels against national averages and where we would expect them to be, in order to get the most out of schooling. Please keep in mind these results are just one of many ways staff at Holy Rosary collect data to support student learning growth.

Our school Athletics carnival will take place this Friday. Thanks in advance to all those who have offered to help it will certainly be a fun day and your time is appreciated. There has certainly been a great deal of practice happening at school and I am sure we will enjoy a fantastic day of action.




