This 'Hats On' period is also extended anytime the UV is consistently 3 or above. With this in mind, we ask all students begin wearing their hats at school.

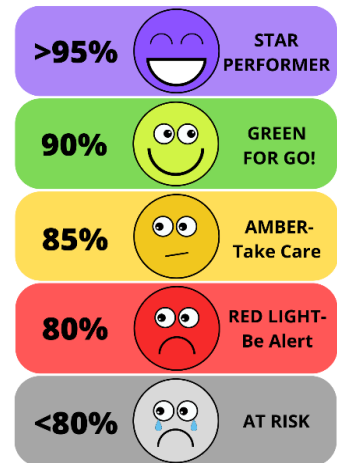
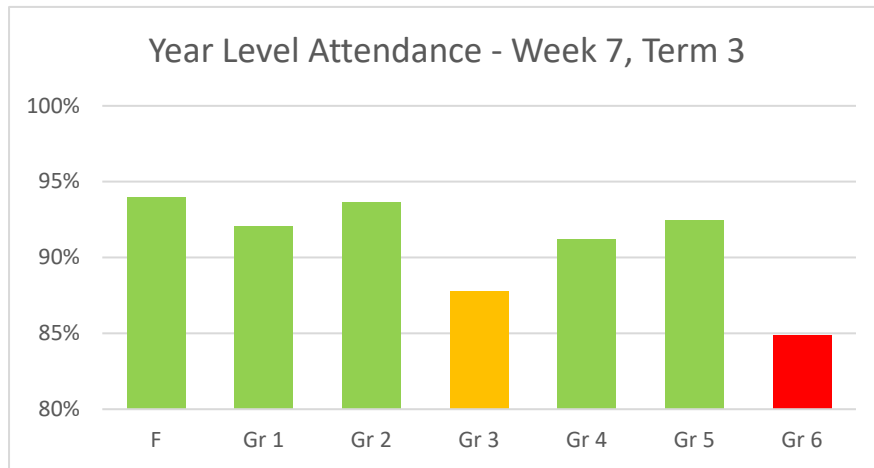

Bags are available to fill with what you require. There is no need to ask before taking, we welcome you to come and just take what you need.

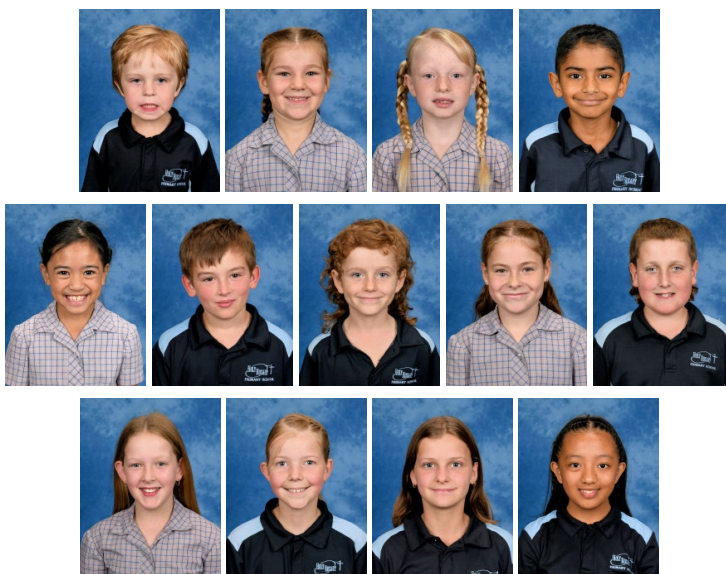

## Recycle your glass bottles and jars for free at our new glass drop off points!

With major changes coming to the way we recycle glass, the City of Greater Bendigo has installed 19 new drop off points for residents to recycle their glass bottles and jars for free.

The Victorian Government's state-wide kerbside reforms and circular economy policy mandates that in the future glass will no longer be able to go in kerbside recycling bins as glass breaks in the compacting process and reduces the quality of other recyclable material.

Glass bottles and jars taken to the new drop off points will be recycled and turned into products for construction work, such as sand for road base.
