## “HATS ON!” AT HOLY ROSARY FROM SEPTEMBER 1

At Holy Rosary, our SunSmart Policy notes that all children will be required to wear school broad brimmed hats from ‘Hats On Day’ - September 1 to ‘Hats Off Day’ - May 1, whenever they are outside including sports lessons. However, if the UV is 3 or above it is recommended hats be worn for protection. Children without hats will be required to remain under cover near the Grade 1 rooms. – ‘NO HAT, NO PLAY’ policy will be enforced.

## PRINCIPAL’S REPORT

Our experience of remote learning has had many variables, challenges and success. During the most recent 'lockdown' we invited the parent community to share with us some of their thoughts and experiences of remote learning, particularly with respect to our schools provision of learning opportunities. Firstly, a thank you to the many families who provided the feedback. I have highlighted some of the data on today's newsletter and hopefully as time passes we will be able to reflect on the information, which will support our learning in the classroom and the partnership with home.

In addition we are also required to conduct a survey about the school with regard to 'climate'. All families received a letter today with details to enable this short online survey to be completed. The data collected will be put together with staff and student data to guide us in future planning throughout the year and into next year. The link to the survey will remain open for the next 2 weeks and I invite all parents to complete a simple survey of about 5-10minutes.

Children are encouraged to dress up as their favourite book character or alternatively, children are welcome to come in their footy colours for the day, as we lead into the AFL Grand Final weekend. 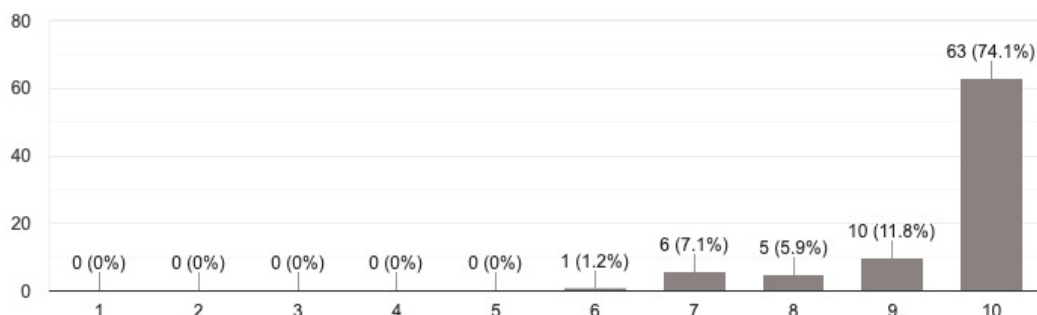
## FAMILY SURVEY RESULTS

1. The classroom teachers have communicated effectively ( e.g. phone calls, email and Google Meets).

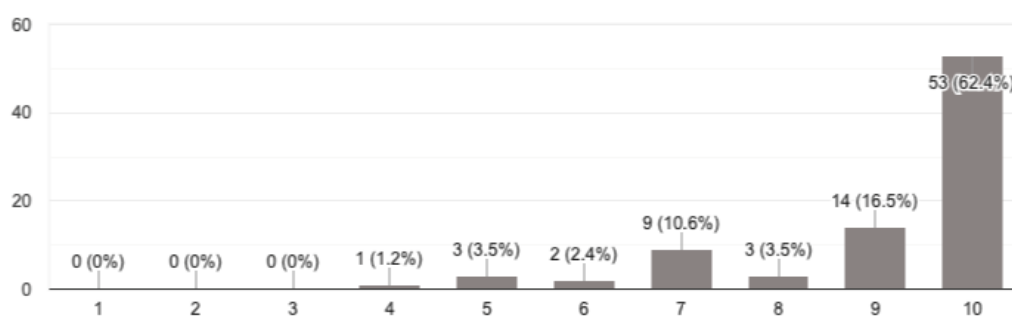

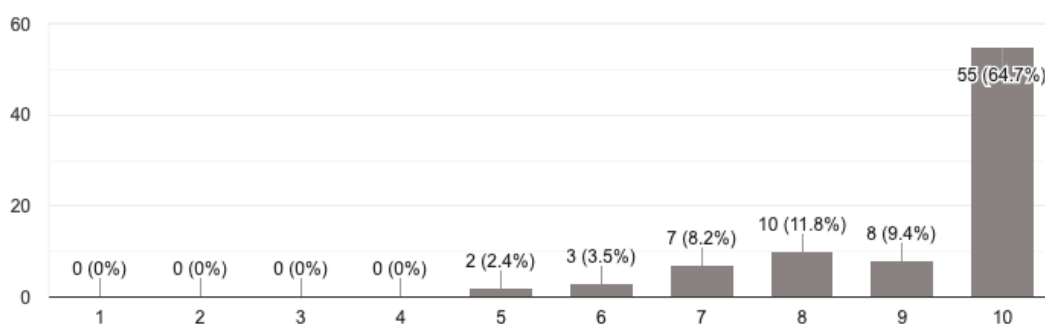
2. Our school has shown care and consideration for student, parent and family wellbeing during the home learning experience.

3. The school newsletter and Coronavirus updates have provided clear communication about remote learning.

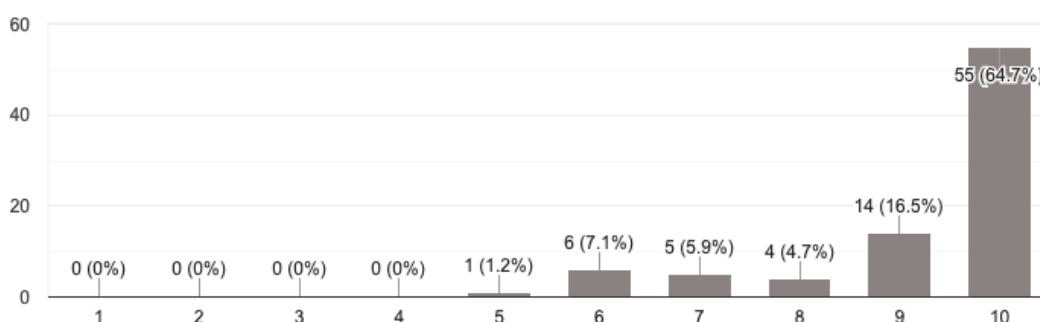

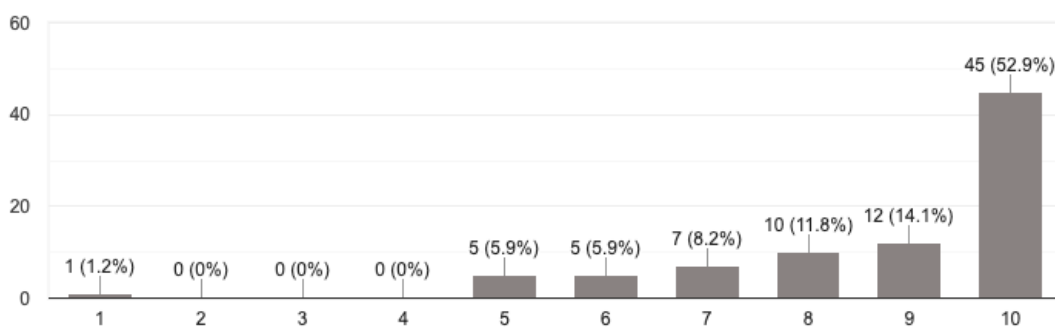

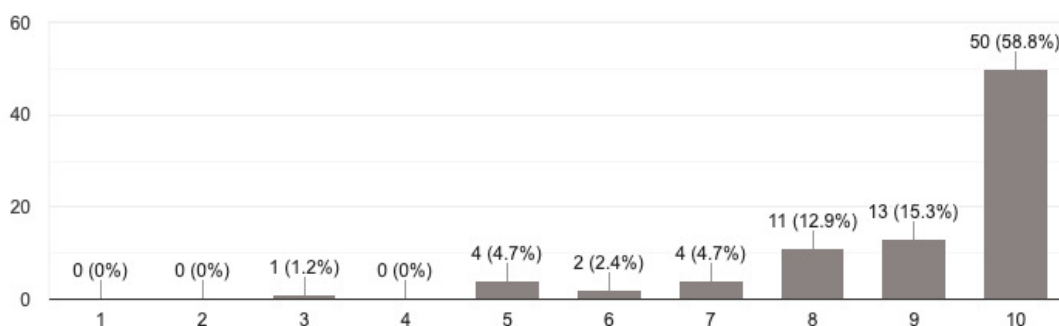
5. Our Facebook communication has kept our community connected during remote learning experiences.

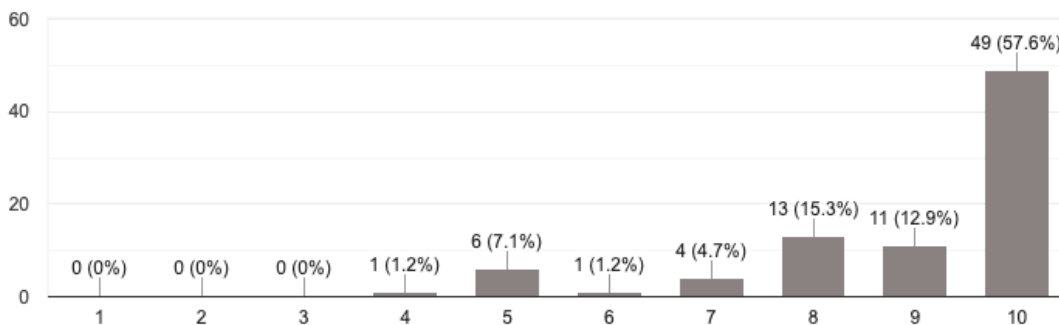
6. Our school has provided an appropriate amount of remote learning opportunities for my child/ren.

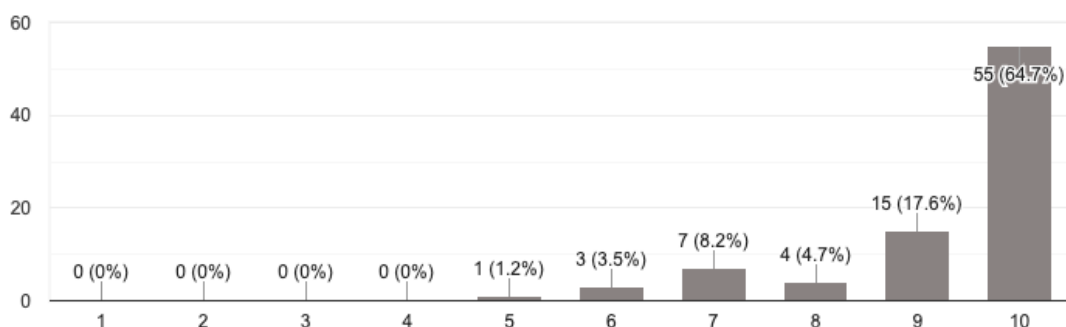
7. Our school has provided quality remote learning opportunities.

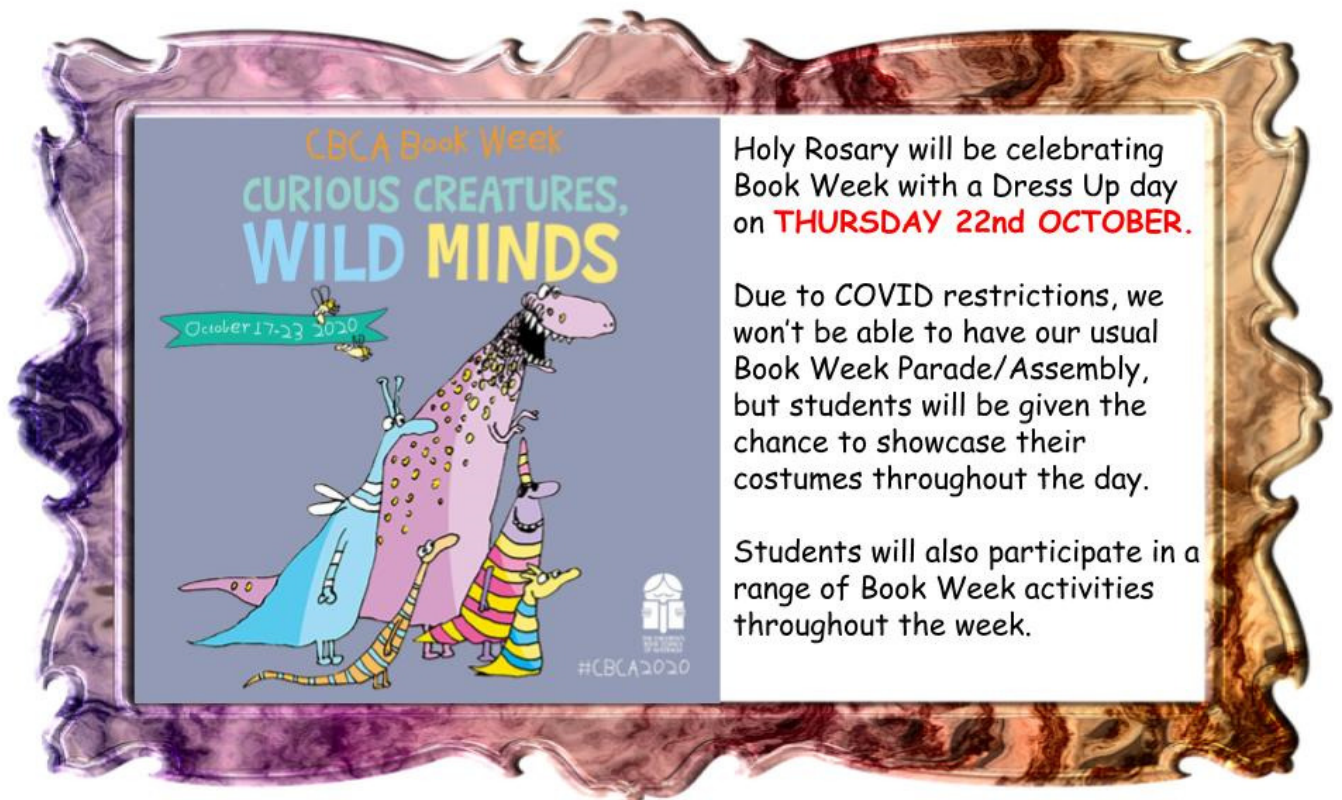


### LIBRARY
