"HATS ON!" AT HOLY ROSARY UNTIL MAY 1

Wellbeing

Welcome back to Term 2. I hope families had an enjoyable holiday break. The start of a new term can often be full of mixed emotions, for both students and parents/carers. Excitement at seeing friends again, yet sometimes difficult to get back into the routine of school/work. Re-establishing routines such as sleep, meal times and homework can be difficult to adjust to. However routine behaviours such as waking at the same time, having breakfast and getting dressed get us ready for the day ahead. They underpin productivity, learning and wellbeing. If we remove or drastically change routines many children (and adults) struggle, particularly those who are prone to anxiety and depression. While holidays are often a time to relax our normal routines, it is important to establish some sort of routine that works for your child/ren and family. Routines can be adapted, and this also helps children build resilience (their ability to cope with change). Daily routines help:

- family life run more smoothly
- families enjoy more time together
- children feel safe, develop life skills and build healthy habits
- parents feel organised, reduce stress and find time for enjoyable activities

One of the most important routines is our sleep routine. The benefits of good sleep routines are enormous and impact children's learning, memory and emotional stability. Sleep restores the brain to optimum condition and rejuvenates the body, allowing hormone levels to stabilise. Sleep-deprived children experience greater anxiety doing routine tasks and have a propensity for pessimistic thinking, which is associated with anxiety and depression. It is not just how long we sleep for, but the quality of our sleep that determines if we are functioning well.


