

## Schedule of Fees and Charges

### 2026 School Fee Structure

The School Fee Structure has been set for the 2026 school year. The Fees and Levies have been determined by the Principal and verified by the School Advisory Board, paying particular attention to the needs and circumstances of the community, along with the ongoing and long-term strategic plan of the school.

### Curriculum & ICT Levy

This levy covers part of the cost of supplies and resources for classrooms and specialist classes, e.g. Art, Music and Drama, Library and Languages. It also assists the school to provide computers and iPads for use across the school.

### Camps, Sports & Excursion (CSE) Levy

This levy covers part of the costs associated with the provision of Camps, Excursions, Incursions and Physical Education Programs

### Payment of School Fees & Levies

The range of educational opportunities and experiences has been offered within the context of our budget. It will therefore be important that payment of fees and levies are honoured. We are very aware of the rising costs for families, and this is given careful consideration in the process of setting school fees and levies. However, due to Government school funding agreements, there is an expectation that Catholic school communities contribute to the cost of education. In order to assist families, we encourage payment via direct debit. This allows for regular payments to be made equally over the year. Please note: If your current payment arrangement is direct debit, you will receive a letter shortly with your revised payment amount for the 2026 school year. For all other forms of payment excluding Direct Debit and Centrepay, fees must be paid in full by 30<sup>th</sup> of April. A Payment Arrangement Form needs to be completed annually and returned to the office ASAP. If any families are experiencing difficulty in paying, they are asked to meet with the Principal to discuss other possible arrangements.

### Payment Options for School Fees & Levies

All fees and levies for the year will be billed at the start of the school year. Families will receive a school fee statement in early February 2026. The school provides a number of payment options for payment of school fees and levies.

- Cash or cheque (accepted via the office)
- Direct Debit (fortnightly)
- Direct payment into school bank account
- Centrepay (Centrelink payments)

## RE: Direct Debiting Fees

Below you will find an example of a direct debit calculation based on a one child family in Foundation beginning their Direct Debit in the first payment cycle of the year. The calculated amount would be deducted from a bank account on a fortnightly basis. This amount would allow the fees to be paid out in full by the end of the year.

We have direct debits occurring fortnightly on both even and odd weeks.

Direct Debit can be set up in 2025 to take effect from the start of the 2026 year, or any time during the year.

If you wish to set up a Direct Debit arrangement, please complete and sign the Direct Debit Request and return it to the School Office. The Direct Debit system will become active on a date to be agreed on and will continue on a fortnightly basis from there, as requested.

You will continue to receive a statement for school fees as this will keep you up to date with your payments and outstanding balance. This is for your information only and will not require a separate payment.

Families with students travelling by bus will receive separate invoices for bus travel. These invoices are not covered by the calculated amount and will need to be paid to the school by cash, cheque or EFT, 14 days from the invoice date.

This arrangement would remain in place until such time that your fees are paid in full, or you choose to stop using the Direct Debit facility. *Existing direct debit users do not have to fill in forms each year. During Term 4 each year, you will receive a letter outlining your new direct debit amount for the following year.*

Please note, that direct debits will cease at the close of the calendar year and recommence at the beginning of Term 1, the following year.

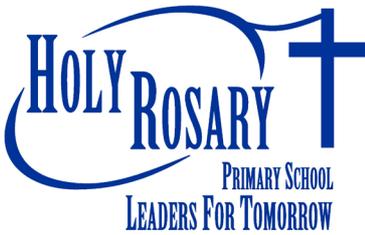
